The journal Pharmacy and Pharmacology has been published since 2022, with a frequency of 1 issue per quarter (4 issues per year).

Articles sent to the journal for publication can be submitted in any of three languages: Uzbek, Russian, English.

The journal "Pharmacy and Pharmacology" publishes articles reflecting the results of previously unpublished and not sent for publication in other publications, completed original research in scientific areas in the field of pharmacy and pharmacology, problematic and review articles in the same areas, as well as articles devoted to improvement of education in Uzbekistan.

Short messages are not accepted.

The editors reserve the right to recommend authors to shorten the manuscript (up to 10 pages of text and 3-5 figures or tables).

Articles are published free of charge.

The article must be accompanied by an official referral from the institution where it was written.

Works published in other publications or sent to other journals cannot be sent to the editorial office.

By submitting an article, the author agrees that the copyright to it passes to the publisher, if it is accepted for publication, at the time of its approval. Copyright includes exclusive rights to copy, distribute (including reprints, photographs, microforms or any other form of reproduction of a similar nature), and translate the article.

Articles accepted for publication are checked for plagiarism at the stage of peer review and scientific editing

Preparation of manuscripts of articles

The manuscript of the article submitted to the editorial office must be formatted in strict accordance with the rules set out below. If these rules are violated, the articles will be returned without consideration.

The volume of the manuscript (including the text of the article, summary, keywords, list of cited literature, tables, figures, information about the authors) should not exceed 15 pages (for review articles).

No more than 5 authors (co-authors) are allowed in the article.

The article must be typed on a computer in Microsoft Office Word. All material must be recorded in one file.

Typesetting options, including tables, figures, charts, bibliography, summary, author information: A4 sheet size, Times New Roman font, size 12, spacing 1.0, all margins (top, bottom, left, right) width 2.5 cm, justified text, indent (paragraph) 1.25 cm, automatic word wrap is prohibited.

All pages should have solid numbering in the lower right corner.

When writing an article, you must adhere to the following structure of presentation:

- UDC
- The title of the article, it should be short (no more than 8 words), but informative enough and, if possible, reflect the main task of the work.
- Initials and surnames of authors
- Full name of the institution (institutions) where the author (authors) works, city, country, abbreviations should not be used in the names of the institution (Research Institute, Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan, TashFarmi, FIM, etc.)
- If there are several authors, each surname and corresponding institution has a digital index. If all authors work in the same institution, the index is not affixed, the institution is indicated once.

Article Summary:

After the information about the authors of the article, a summary with keywords is given in regular (not italicized or bold) font.

The title "Summary" is not printed.

The author's abstract for the article is the main source of information in domestic and foreign information systems and databases that index the journal.

The abstract should state only the essential facts of the work. It is recommended to build the majority of sentences according to the model: "Discovered...", "Established...", "Clarified...", "Estimated influence...", "Regularities are characterized...", "Considered...", etc.

The volume of the summary is 200–250 words. A separate line contains keywords (5-7 words in the nominative case), which contribute to the indexing of the article in search engines. If the object of research is a medicinal plant, its Russian and Latin names are indicated in the keywords.

The summary is written in three languages: at the beginning of the article - in the original language of the article, at the end - in two other languages (for example, the article is written in Uzbek, at the beginning of the summary - in Uzbek, and at the end of the article - in Russian and English, indicating the title of the article, authors, institutions, cities and countries)

Building the text of the article:

- introduction
- materials and research methods
- results
- conclusions
- Bibliography

Bibliography:

The bibliography should contain publications for the last 10 years.

Links to Internet resources are allowed in a limited number - no more than 3. Self-citation should be avoided, except when it seems necessary (for example, if there are no other sources of information, or this work was carried out on the basis of or in continuation of the cited studies). It is not allowed to include in the list of literature sources that are not referenced in the text of the article.

References to the literature (no more than 15 for experimental works, no more than 20 for review articles) are indicated in the order of citation in the manuscript. The text gives a reference to the serial number of the cited work in square brackets [1] or [1, 2]. Each reference in the bibliography is given on a new line. A bibliographic record is compiled once, but it can be referred to in the text more than once.

The reference to the literature must necessarily contain the full name of the authors, the title of the article, bibliographic imprint. It is unacceptable to abbreviate the title of the article.

When citing journal articles (the most common source of information to cite), the following pattern should be followed:

Author A.A., Co-author B.B. Article title. Name of the journal. Year; volume (number): p.–p. DOI (DOI- if available).
